Music City Texas Conduct Policy

I. Principle

Music City Texas Theater (hereafter referred to as the "Theater") provides equal and open access to its Patrons and customer. While everyone has an equal right to access the Theater no one has the right to interfere with the ability of others to enjoy the entertainment presented.

Music City Texas Theater (hereafter referred to as MCT) maintains the right to expel from the Theater any individual who contributed to a disruptive, unsafe or unwelcoming environment.

II. Expected Behavior

To maintain a welcoming environment for all customer of the Theater, you are expect to:

- Attend to your personal belongings. The Theater is not responsible for lost items.
- b. Allow staff to look in bags in case of security concerns.
- Enjoy food and drinks responsibility while in the Theater.
- d. Use public restrooms for intended purposes only.
- Stay out of non-public area, such as offices, store rooms and Green Room unless authorized by staff or Board Member.

III. Inappropriate Behavior

The Following actions and behaviors are deemed inappropriate on Theater property and thus prohibited:

- Disruptive, uncontrolled or unsafe behavior.
- b. Possession of weapons.
- Intoxication, either by alcohol or other mind-altering drugs to the point of impairment of one's mental or physical abilities. C.
- d. Intentional physical damage to persons or property within the Theater.
- Smoking within the Theater.
- f. Attempts to fraudulently obtain tickets to performances presented by MCT.

IV. MCT response to policy violations

Any person/s that violates Patron Conduct Policy shall be expelled from the Theater.
